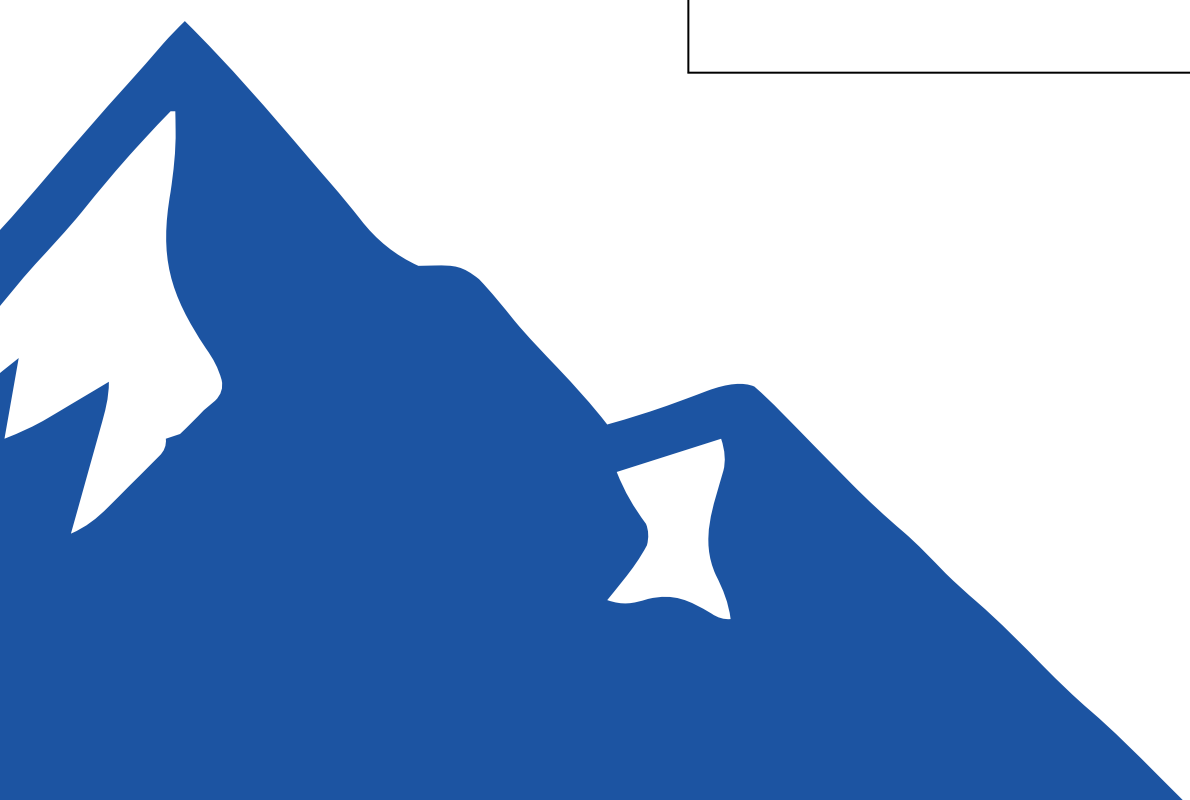

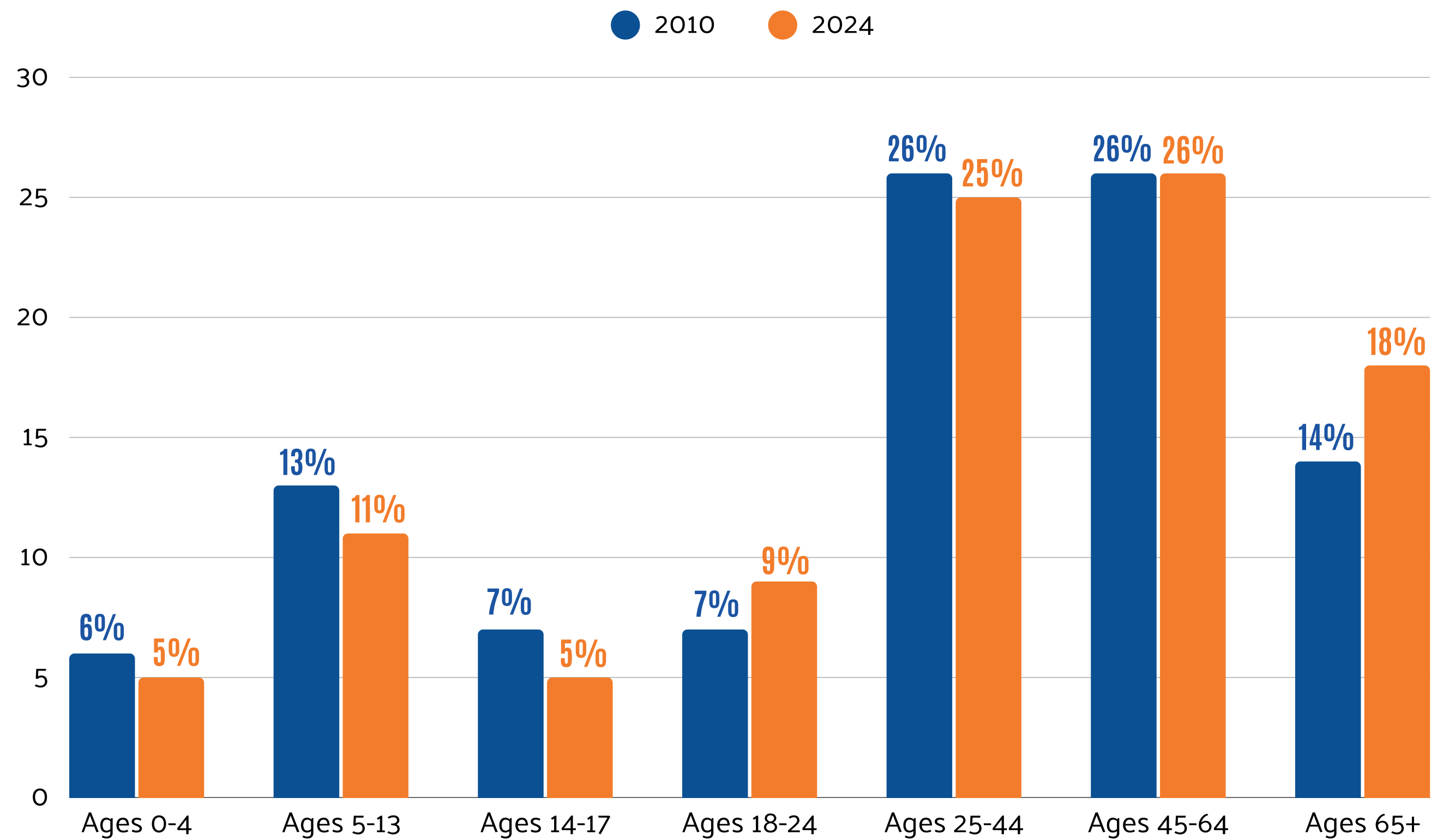

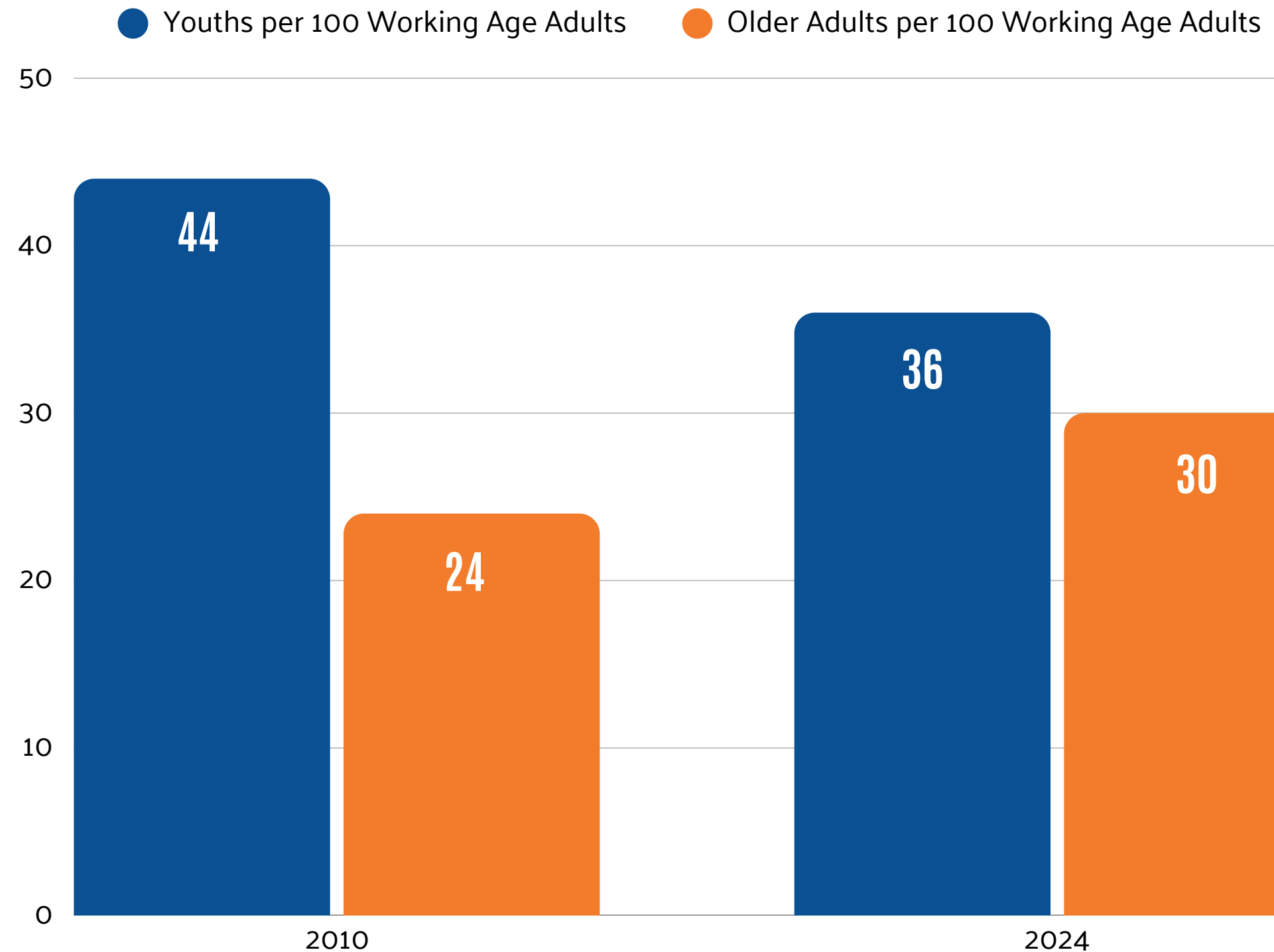
PERCENT OF POPULATION ACROSS AGE RANGES 2010 AND 2024



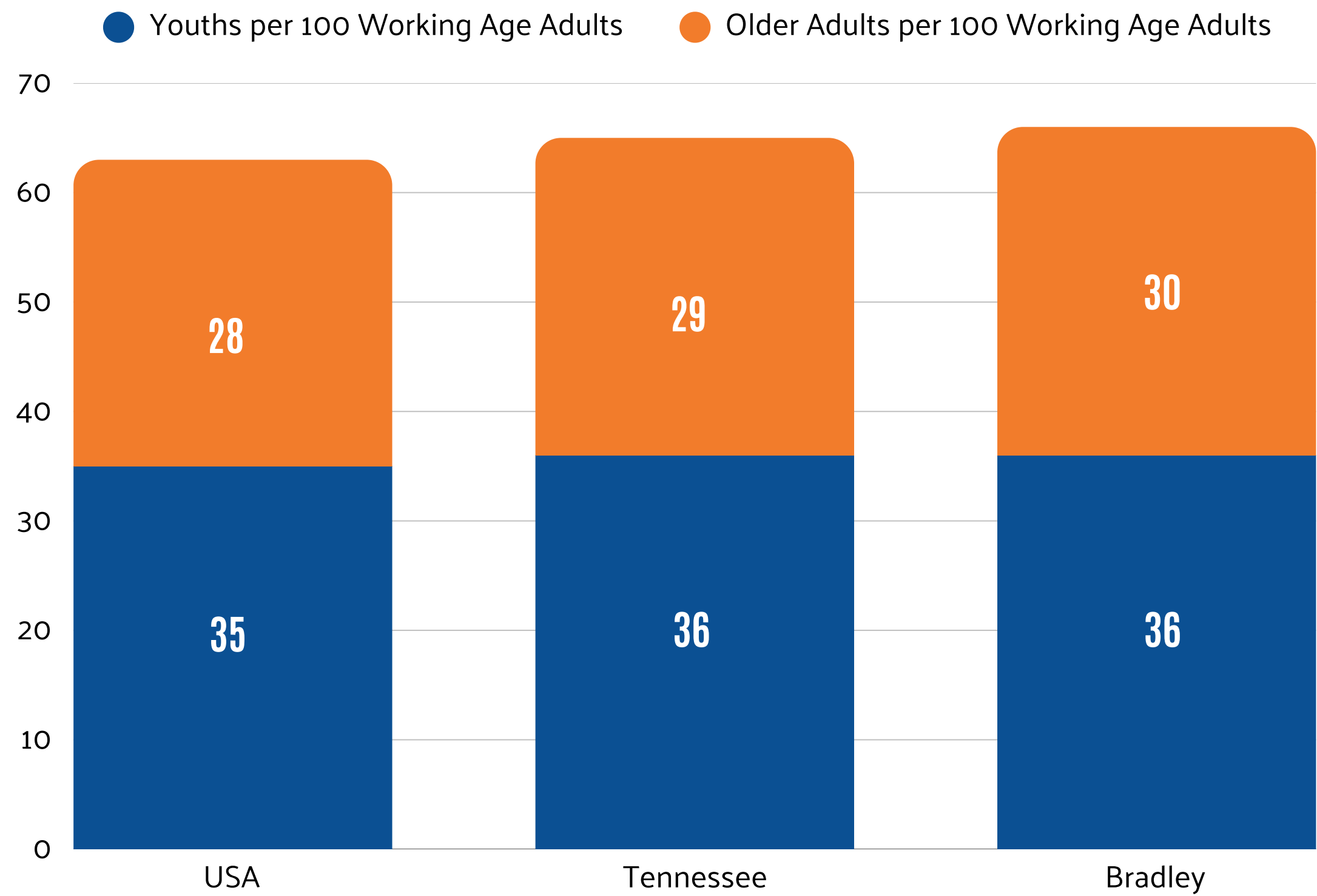
AGE-SPECIFIC DEPENDENCY RATIOS BY YEAR

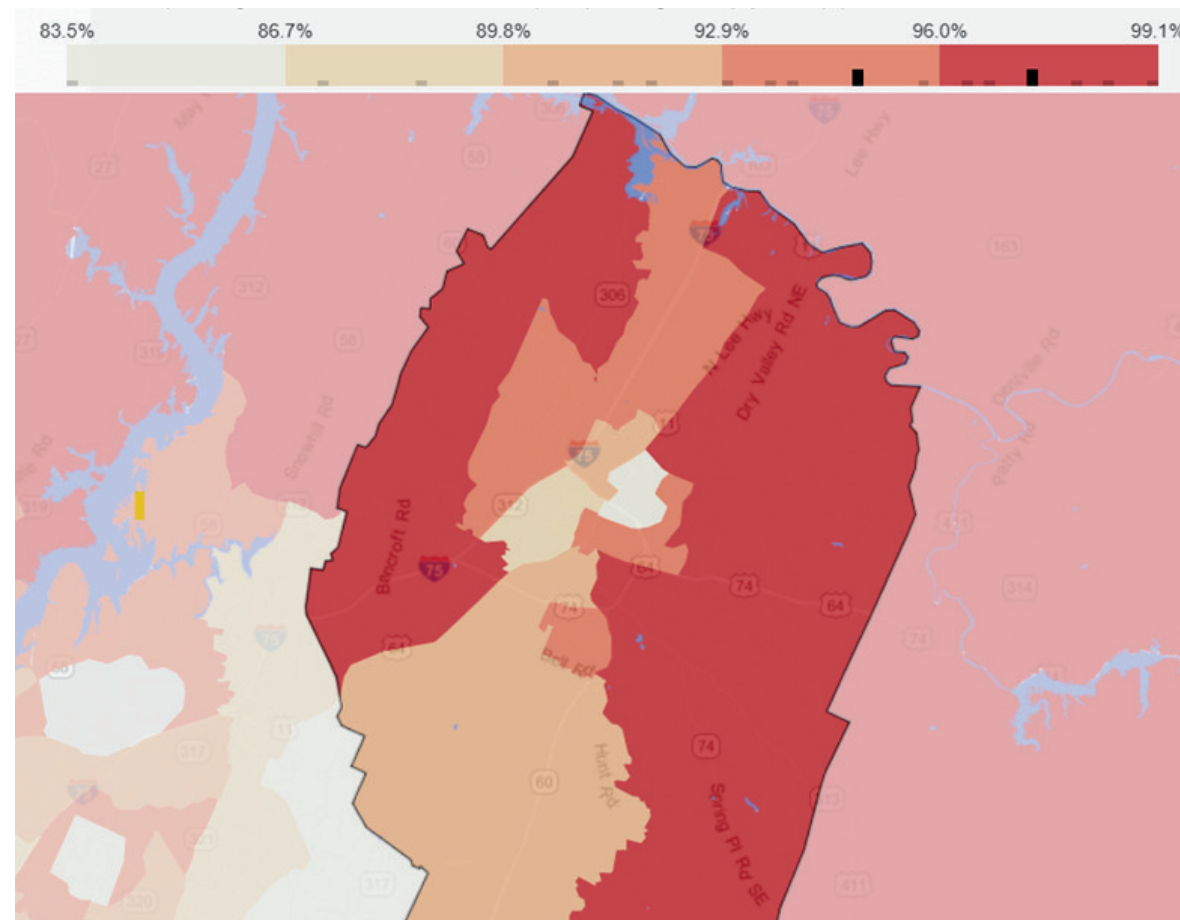

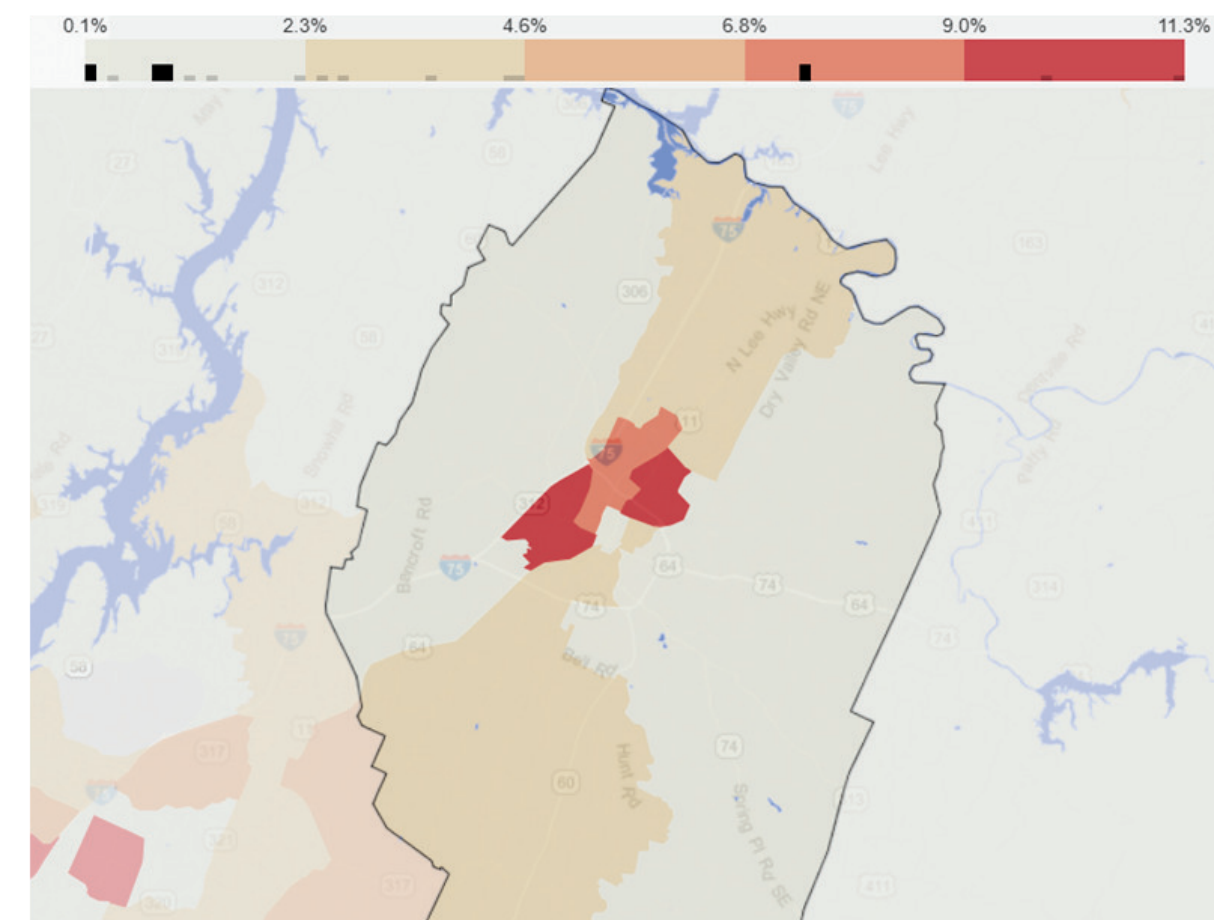

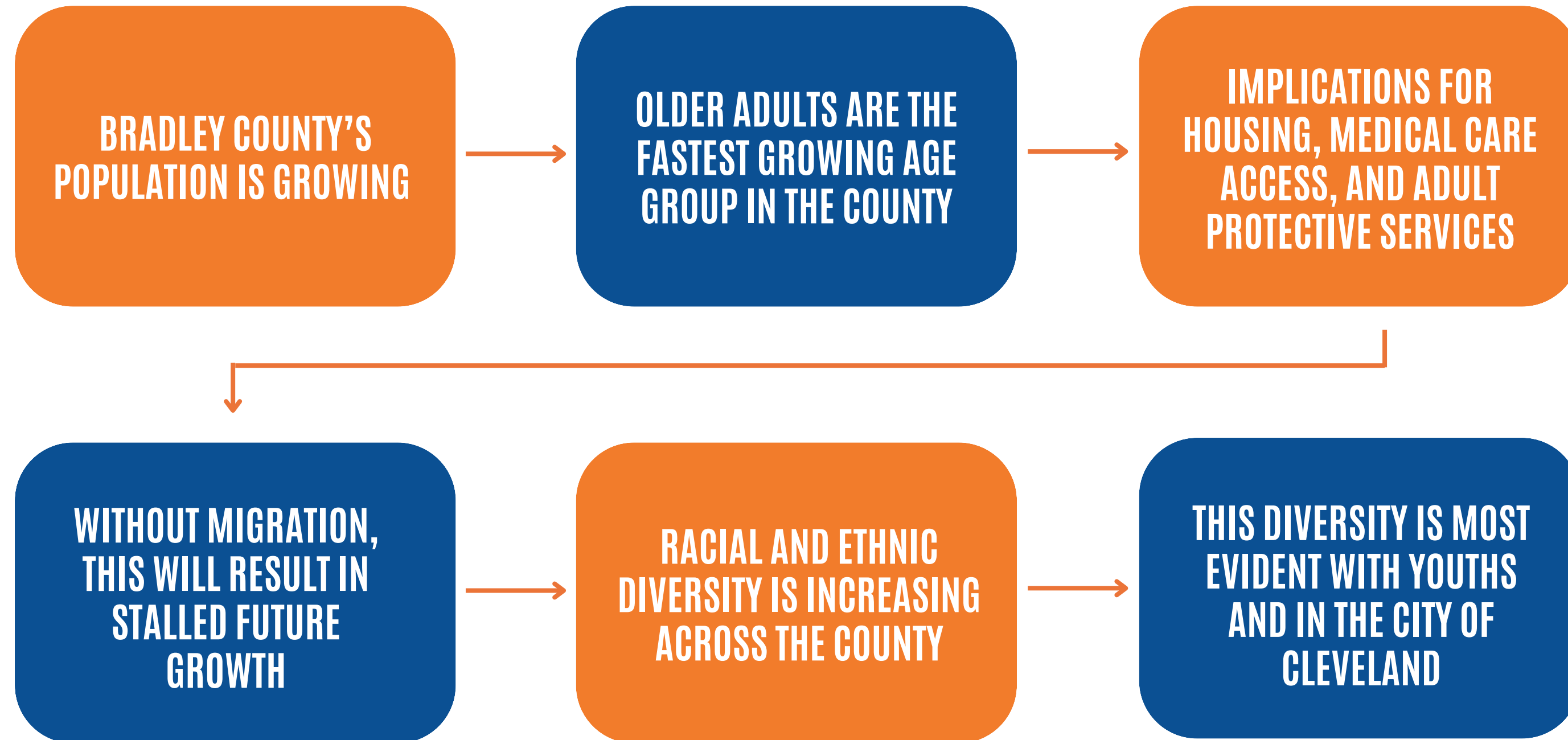
